



HERITAGE SHED RESTORATION

Restoring the market you know and love

In May 2020, we began a major \$30 million restoration of the market's iconic sheds – the largest ever investment in the market's 142-year history.

The first stage of restoration - Sheds J to M - is now complete and traders have been welcomed back. The project now moves to Stage 2 - Sheds C and D.

Traders in Sheds C and D have relocated to E Shed and the newly restored Sheds J to L. The market remains open for business throughout shed restoration works and if you can't find your favourite trader, pop in to the Visitor Hub at the end of String Bean Alley and ask for directions.

All 12 of the market's heritage sheds will now be restored on-site by the end of 2022, subject to any future COVID19 impacts. The works are authorised under Heritage Victoria Permit Number P318866.

Thanks for your patience as we undertake these important restoration works.

Stage 2: Sheds C and D

The heritage shed restoration project has now moved to Stage 2 with works across Sheds C and D.

Works include:

- repair and strengthening of metal elements such as trusses
- repair of timber elements
- repair of verandahs
- painting
- new insulated roofing to improve the temperature under the sheds so it's cooler in summer
- upgrade of services including power and lighting

The works area will be fenced off for the duration of Stage 2, with safe passage through the upper market via the centre walkways on market days.

Please take care and be mindful of changed conditions around the area.

What's happening: Stage 2



Work area

Stage 2 includes Sheds C and D (see map below), with works occurring Monday to Saturday. Walkway access will remain open on market days to ensure safe pedestrian access through the area. Thank you for your patience while we undertake these important restoration works.



Noise

Traders and customers in close proximity to the works areas may experience some inconvenience. Works are expected to generate low to medium levels of noise. Work is being undertaken with COVID-19 health and safety measures in place and in accordance with WorkSafe and EPA guidelines.



Pedestrian access

The work areas will be fenced off for the duration of Stage 2, with safe passage through the upper market via the centre walkways. Signage on temporary fencing will assist pedestrian wayfinding and safe access around the work site. Please take care and be mindful of changed conditions around the area.
