

Fact Sheet: Green Our Rooftop Demonstration Green Roof Project

The Green Our Rooftop Demonstration Green Roof Project supports the City of Melbourne and Victorian Government's shared goal for Melbourne to be a bold, inspirational and sustainable city.

The combined City of Melbourne and DELWP project budget for the project is \$2.5 million. (matched funding of \$1.25 million each). The project aims to:

- Demonstrate how to successfully retrofit a building with a high quality green roof.
- Educate the public about green roofs in an interactive way.
- Demonstrate the benefits of green roofs through research.
- Provide environmental and social benefits



On the 23rd of May 2019,

Victorian Minister for Energy, Environment and Climate Change and Minister for Solar Homes Lily D'Ambrosio announced City of Melbourne and the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning's joint project to transform the Department of Treasury and Finance's rooftop at 1 Treasury Place into a green rooftop. A building feasibility study confirmed the suitability of 1,500m² green roof at 1 Treasury Place, East Melbourne, the use of which was given approval by the Minister for Finance in November 2018. The cost of the building works at 1 Treasury is \$1.304 Million. Construction is expected to begin in early 2020, and completed by June 2020

The 1 Treasury Place will be made available for research projects deemed successful.
